Scope of the Environmental Management System

When determining the scope for the environmental management system, top management takes into consideration the relevant needs of interested parties, including the organisation's compliance obligations (4.2) and the relevant external and internal issues (4.1) to the extent that they impact on our EMS, processes, products and services. This activity is carried out at Strategic Meetings but also reviewed and monitored via the annual Management Review, and all the information is documented on a spreadsheet which is controlled within the QA Department and logged in the Business Management Software, Q-Pulse.

The scope for products and services is *'The process of stockholding and supply of pipes, pipe fittings, flanges, associated piping materials and Stainless Steel, Nickel Alloy and other Exotic metal round, flat and square bar'*.

Dukinfield is the only site with ISO 14001 certification. However, as the head office it does have the authority and ability to influence differing levels of control on the activities, products and services performed at other sites.
